Complications of Ectopic gestation

These are related to misdiagnosis, late diagnosis or surgical intervention

Complications related to delayed/misdiagnosis

- 1. Tubal rupture(Leading to haemorrhage leading to hypovolaemic shock)
- 2. Disseminated intravascular coagulation (DIC)
- 3. Infertility (10-15% up to 50 %)
- 4. Psychological Especially depression. Results from;
 - Loss of foetus
 - Surgery
 - Loss of reproductive organs
 - Disruption to family life
 - Hormonal changes

Complications related to surgery

- 1. Anaesthetic
- 2. Loss of reproductive organs
- 3. urinary/intestinal fistula
- 4. Haemorrhage
- 5. Infection
- 6. Repeat ectopic. (7-10% of cases).
 - Depends on the type of surgery –laparoscopic; 6-16%, laparotomy; 7-28%
 - In cases associated with IUCD risk less if device removed
