Left Lower Quadrant Pain

Significance of site of Pain

Right Upper Quadrant	Biliary tract, liver
Epigastric	Usually foregut structures i.e. Stomach, duodenum, lower oesophagus, biliary tract, pancreas Can also get cardiac pain referred here
Left Upper Quadrant	Spleen, stomach
Central	Midgut Structures: small and large bowel or pancreas
Right Iliac fossa	Caecum, appendix, ovary, right kidney ureter mesenteric adentitis
Suprapubic	Bladder, uterus, adenexae
Left iliac fossa	Sigmoid colon, left kidney, ureter
Loins	Kidneys and ureters

Causes of left lower quadrant pain

Ulcerative colitis Crohns disease Antibiotic associated colitis Ischaemic colitis

Inflammatory Bowel Disease Chronic constipation Diverticular Disease

These are related to disordered peristaltic function attributable to modified diet.

Symptoms:

Intermittent abdominal pain Erratic bowel Habit Bloating and excessive flatus

Sigmoid volvulus

Dilated sigmoid loop - history of several episodes of transient obstruction some episodes diagnosed as constipation and resolve when constipation is treated.

Sorry there is no way I could do a flow pathway for those presenting with abdominal pain ...very complicated and a lot depends on history and indeed frequency of symptoms and signs.
