Stroke


0.24% of the population per year suffer a stroke for the first time
25% of men and 20% of women over 45 years will have a stroke by the age of 85 years

 Myocardial Infarction 0.56% of the population experience an MI per year 2.4% of the population have suffered an MI

 Peripheral Vascular Disease Symptomatic PVD increases with age: - 0.2% per year in men of 35-45 years - 7% of 50-75 year-olds


CO-EXISTENCE OF CORONARY, CEREBRAL, AND PERIPHERAL VASCULAR DISEASE

Prevalence of vascular disease in a population 62 years of age and over







PLAQUE RUPTURE AND THROMBUS FORMATION


