PID
Ectopic pregnancy
UTI
Appendicitis

Give three diagnostic criteria(3 marks)

Low abdominal pain
Adnexal tenderness
Cervical excitation

What are the indications for admission? (3 marks)

Unable to take oral medications
Unable to control pain with oral analgesia
Sepsis
Adolescent with poor circumstances
